

## **CHAPTER MB: Migratory Bird Harvesting**

### **Definitions**

In this chapter, “Migratory Bird” means a migratory bird referred to in the Migratory Birds Convention, and includes the eggs, embryos and parts of the bird.

Conservation means:

- a) the maintenance of the integrity of ecosystems by measures such as the protection and reclamation of Migratory Bird habitat and, where necessary, restoration of Migratory Bird habitat; and
- b) the maintenance of vital, healthy Migratory Bird populations capable of sustaining Harvesting under the Agreement.

Dehcho Citizen means a person whose name is on the Dehcho Register.

Dehcho Agreement means this land claims and self-government agreement.
